# Superintendent – Rick Durham

We are ahead of where we were last year at this time with course conditions. Warmer weather is beginning to be more consistent has played a role in this. Agronomically, we have several applications planned for the month of May. Fairways, tees and roughs will be fertilized. Aerification will begin in these areas to assist with reducing compaction and creating healthier turf. Watering schedules have already been set and are being utilized nightly. Greens top dressing began early on in April and we are already seeing benefits. This will continue weekly through the growing season. With the renovation of the right side of number nine behind us we have started working on enlarging tees. This process involves stripping existing turf so the soil profile can easily be graded. After we have finished a rough grade, new irrigation will be added to replace older sprinklers and pipes. A finish leveling grade is last step before sodding with new grass. Once the maintenance team has installed new sod, we are expecting two to three weeks before playing on new surface. 
# **April Trifecta of Hole-In Ones!**



WILDWOOD GREEN HOLE 11

#### How to play water, out of bounds and lost balls on

HOLE # 11 by the Wildflowers LOCAL RULES





This par 4 is the shortest one on the course, but it can come out and

bite you if you are too aggressive off the tee. If you carry the water in front of the tee box and avoid the creek on the left, a well placed tee shot will leave you with a wedge approach.

#### Wildflowers Local Rules ONLY for Hole 11 not USGA Rules

- If you hit into the water, you may either hit another ball to go over (1 stroke penalty) or take the ball to the "FAMILY TEE" in front of cart path over the water (1 stroke penalty). You are now hitting # 3.
- If you hit to the right where near the homes and trees are;

 Any ball deemed to be lost or our of bounds (in homes or bushes), may hit a Provisional Ball at tee box and then look for ball. If first ball is lost and you have hit Provisional ball over water safely, you lie 3. (You cannot look for first ball until you first hit a Provisional if you choose this strategy. OR

 If any ball deemed to be lost or out of bounds (in homes or bushes) you may hit from the area where the ball was last seem, one stroke penalty, you are now hitting your # 3 shot.

<u>REMINDER</u>: We are on a 4 hour & 15 minute golf round. "Ready Golf" means all golfers should go to their balls as soon as safely possible and get ready to play their shots. While waiting to hit, players should survey their shot, select their club and stand at their ball ready to go when it is their turn.

#### Don't forget to enter your scores each week, to keep handicap current.
