Originally established in 1986, Wildwood Green's beautiful terrain of rolling green and woods is a peaceful sight to the eye. We made a great thing even better completing a major redesign in 1996 and then installing Champion Bermudagrass greens in 2017. Wildwood Green was created with all players in mind. Our course consists of 7 sets of tees for all skill levels. Whether you are looking for a place to spend a beautiful afternoon or a lifetime of beautiful afternoons, escape to Wildwood Green Golf Club.

Better than the rest...

Wildwood Green was purchased by Roger and Sandy Watson in 1986 and was redesigned in the fall of 1996 by John LaFoy. LaFoy was voted one of the 10 best golf course designers in America by several national publications. Local projects include: Devils Ridge Golf Club, The Neuse Golf Club, North Ridge Country Club and Carolina Country Club. Landscapes Unlimited, the original contractor for the project, was voted the #1 golf course builder in the United States 9 times. Champion Bermudagrass greens were installed in 2017 and are often deemed the best in the Triangle. With cart path replacement in 2019-2021 and bunker renovations in 2023, Wildwood Green maintains some of the best and most consistent course conditions in the area.

Capital Improvements

Since our first major improvement of installing the Champion Ultradwarf Bermudagrass greens in 2017, we have improved the golf course tees, driving range and lesson tee, golf carts, cart paths, landscaping, general improvements around the clubhouse, added an awning at the back patio, enclosed the pavilion, remodeled Champions Grille, remodeled the golf shop, automated irrigation at the greens, fairways, tees and range, paved the parking lots, and added additional benches and ice/water machines around the facility.

We dredged the pond at #5 green, cleaned the lake at #12 and enlarged the forward tee, removed some more trees throughout the property, improved and enlarged the lesson tee area, cleaned some underbrush on the course and continued our beautification projects. In April of 2021 we installed a new point of sale operating system and outfitted the golf carts with GPS touch screens.

In 2022 we were named the HV3 Foundation's 2022 Youth on Course Facility of the Year for the Carolinas, voted 2nd Place in the News & Observer's Best Golf Courses by readers and residents of Raleigh, expanded the lesson tee and added a new teeing area, installed higher netting and poles along Strickland Road at the Driving Range in addition to the net placed between the range and hole #1, completed cart path repairs and added a new cart path across #1 fairway, renovated the halfway house restrooms, cleared underbrush between holes #2-#3-#4 as well as #4-#5, and added handrails to the steps at holes #8, #9, and #13.

In 2023 we were voted the #31 Best Course You Can Play by the NC Golf Panel, installed new cart paths on hole #8, #11, and #12, added a cart path and turn around at the #6 forward tee, added riprap to several creeks and drainage areas around the course, added an additional teaching tee area, and renovated most of the bunkers.

We desire to build upon these improvements and make sure we have the best facility in our area, providing you "the best bang for your buck"!

In our efforts to help you improve your game, we have instructors on site with the most years of teaching experience offered in the area. We have the best club selections and the best prices in town for our members. Most club repair and club alterations can be done on site.

Member Events

Tournaments

Member-Member - Our spring and fall member-member tournaments are two of our most popular events. Both are two day events and consist of 50-60 two person teams that are sorted into flights based off handicap. Flight winners move on to an overall playoff that no one wants to miss!

Member-Guest - The most anticipated tournament at Wildwood Green which focuses on providing value and creating one of the most action-packed weekends of the year. This event consists of 60 two-person teams who compete in a flighted round-robin match play competition playing 45 holes over the course of two days.

Club Championship - The most prestigious title at Wildwood Green must be the title of Club Champion. This two-day stroke play competition, which hosts the club's best golfers, will undoubtedly see great scores again this next year. The Club Championship will be flighted by age and then by handicap.

Ryder Cup - Once a year, we host a Ryder Cup style golf tournament. The Ryder Cup is a 36-hole match play event which features two days of competition. This event will consist of 4 different matches played throughout two days, and 4 separate 9-hole competitions .

Couples Golf & Parent Child Golf - We host our Couples Golf & Parent Child Golf events throughout the summer season. These 9-hole golf events are always a fun way to meet other couples and families at the Club. We have had incredible participation over the past few years. Each year the participation grows and has turned into our most popular 9-hole competition. Our couples and parent child events are held Sunday evenings, then followed with a delicious dinner provided by Champions Grille.

Skins Day - Most tournaments and leagues involve skins games and/or a hat pool. We also run a monthly skins game available to all players with a tee time that day.

Special Events - Wildwood Green hosts a variety of special events including, but not limited to: Par 3 Events, Major Championship Pools, Weekly 50/50 Drawing, Member-Partners, Superintendents Revenge Day, Flag Day, Horse Race, Glow Golf, 3 Clubs & a Putter, CGA Events, and more!

Year Long Match Play - The event will be broken down into 16 different groups. Groups and seedings will be determined by the player's handicap index after the April 30th handicap revision. Groups should each have an A, B, C, D, and E player to keep handicaps fair and evenly spread. Group winners move on to a 16 player single elimination bracket.

Leagues

WildFlowers - The Wildflowers is a women's golf group at Wildwood Green Golf Club that plays a scheduled game format of 18 holes each Tuesday morning in the months March through October. WildFlowers have 2 tee times available for 8 players every Thursday to get some extra golf in.

WildOats - The WildOats is open to men members who are 50 years and older. The WildOats meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays throughout the year. The starting time fluctuates with the seasons.

Gaggle - The Gaggle is a men's member group open to members and accompanied guests of Wildwood Green. The Gaggle plays Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays all year round usually starting with 10:00 AM tee times.

MGA - The MGA will swing into action starting in May and will run thru September. Golfers will meet each Monday evening with tee times starting around 5:30 PM and play nine holes of match play.

Medalist Game - The Medalist Game is to be held once a month on Sunday mornings. This is a gross only game meant for lower handicap golfers and those looking for competition style golf. Tee times are reserved and assigned by the golf shop and normal play WILL NOT be disturbed on these days.

Member Run Groups - We feature many member run groups on most days of the week for both men and women. The golf shop would be happy to get you in contact with any group you have an interest to join.
