Hours Update:

Friday-Sunday shotguns will continue until the time change in March which is at 2:00 AM on the morning of March 9th. After that, we will switch back and host tee times each day of the week. Our range hours will change this month. Our last bucket of balls will be sold at 5:00 PM Monday-Saturday and at 3:00 PM on Sunday. The driving range will have a hard closing time of 30 minutes AFTER the last bucket is sold. Sundays we perform a clean pick of the range so we appreciate your understanding of the earlier closing time.

Waitlist Information:

As you all know very well, tee times can be competitive and tough to get for some. Myself and my staff work diligently to keep the tee sheet as clean as possible and ensure everyone who desires a tee time get's one. We continue to have openings available in our shotguns and no one on the waitlist to call. If you look online 15-7 days out and don't see anything, don't give up! Call or email the golf shop to get your name on the waitlist, you have a really good chance of getting your desired tee time. Many times when people tell me they are NEVER able to get a tee time, I ask them "Do you ever call or do you just look online?". The common response is "Oh I just looked online 10 days before and didn't see anything". GET ON THE WAITLIST, we cannot book you a tee time if we do not know you are looking for it. Superintendent — Rick Durham

The start of 2025 has been challenging for golf, with severe frigid conditions impacting the course. Our maintenance team at Wildwood has been working diligently to protect our greens during this time. When temperatures are forecasted to dip into the low twenties or below, we take precautionary measures to safeguard the turf. The hardest conditions for our putting surfaces occur when daily high temperatures don't rise above freezing, which unfortunately was the case throughout January.

To protect the greens, we've used covers on several occasions and took extra steps to shield them. For our shaded and more vulnerable greens, we added pine straw for added insulation. We greatly appreciate your continued support and remain hopeful that spring-like conditions are on the horizon.

Despite the tough weather, the maintenance team has stayed productive. We're in the process of preparing equipment for the upcoming season, with all machinery being serviced. Additionally, the shop and maintenance yard are being organized for efficiency. We've also ordered new flags and flagpoles, along with a few other accessories.

At the moment, no major projects are underway, but once the weather improves, we'll focus on tree work and expanding tee boxes. Thank you for your feedback and suggestions. As always, feel free to reach out to me directly at rdurham@wildwoodgreen.com.

The tournament on March 15th affects tee time booking on Friday, February 28th. No tee times available until 3:00 PM on March 15th.


Sign-ups will open on February 16th, so be sure to mark your calendars!
